

Flag lowering ceremony for the Pat Heung Fire Services Training Centre

The Fire Services Department (FSD) today (January 29) held a flag lowering ceremony at the Pat Heung Fire Services Training Centre to mark the official closure of the Centre. The Pat Heung Fire Services Training Centre, formerly named Pat Heung Fire Services Training School, was open in 1968 and has over the years trained 12 572 fire and ambulance personnel, including 1 460 station officers, 97 ambulance officers, 372 personnel of the Mobilising and Communications Group, 8 048 firemen and 2 595 ambulancemen. Apart from providing basic training for new recruits, it also provides advanced and continuous training for all in-service fire and ambulance personnel.
