IMPORTANT ADVICE DOs & DON'Ts for Applicants – Massage Establishment

DOs

- DO write to or call up the Planning Department to see if planning permission is required for the setting up of a massage establishment in the proposed location.
- DO prepare three copies of layout plans and air-conditioning / ventilation layout plans of the proposed premises drawn to scale (of a ratio not less than 1:100) and in metric units for submission together with the application to the Police Licensing Office.
- DO appoint a registered fire service installation contractor for carrying out the works of installation / alteration / addition of fire service installation and equipment
- DO appoint a registered specialist contractor (ventilation works category) to certify that the works of installation / alteration / addition of mechanical ventilating system and the associated ventilating drawing comply with the Building (Ventilating Systems) Regulations, Cap.123J and the fire safety requirements as specified in the Fire Services Department Circular Letters.

DON'Ts

- DON'T choose premises at industrial buildings.
- DON'T choose premises at level three of a basement or below.
- DON'T choose premises in areas designated for emergency use.

Note: The above advice only provided for facilitating the compliance of fire safety requirements, applicants are strongly advised to observe the conditions as stipulated by the Licensing Authority and other Government departments.
