

Breach of Licensing Conditions (DGV)

Pursuant to Regulations 75 and 101 of the Dangerous Goods (General) Regulations, Cap 295(B), Laws of Hong Kong, no person shall use, or cause or permit to be used, any mechanically propelled vehicle for the conveyance by road of any dangerous goods in Category 2 [other than LP Gas] and/or Category 5 unless the use of such vehicle has been approved by the Authority.

The DGV Licensees should always comply with the licensing conditions. Any contravention to licensing condition shall constitute an offence which shall be punishable on summary conviction by a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and imprisonment not exceeding 1 month.

The common DGV offences that would easily be discovered as follows:

- i) Whenever the DGV is loaded with DG, it should be attended at all times.
- ii) Smoking on DGV is prohibited.
- iii) Decanting of Category 5 DG from DGV.
- iv) Direct fuelling of Category 5 DG from any tank wagon to the fuel tank of vehicle.
