火警調查犬主要負責協助火警調查人員確定火場是否有助燃劑。狗的嗅覺靈敏，能夠準確地偵測到火場是否有助燃劑，因牠們動作敏捷，可以快速及有效地搜索大面積的火場範圍，有助縮短調查人員挖掘及收集餘燼所需要的時間。現時本處共有三隊火警調查犬隊，每隊由一名領犬員和一頭火警調查犬組成。該三頭火警調查犬(森仔、安仔和巴斯)均為拉布拉多尋回犬，牠們已完成訓練並能偵測出六種縱火時常用的助燃劑，包括電油、柴油、火水、松節水、天拿水和白電油。

Fire Investigation Dogs (FIDs) are mainly responsible for assisting fire investigators in identifying the presence of accelerant at the fire scene. Dogs have a superior sense of smell and can accurately detect the presence of accelerant at fire scenes. They are very agile and able to search a large area quickly and efficiently, thus shortening the time required for excavation and debris sampling by the investigators.

At present, there are three FID teams in the Fire Services Department, each consisting of one handler and one dog.

The three FIDs (Sam, Olly and Buzz) are Labrador Retrievers. They have completed their training and are able to detect six kinds of accelerants commonly used to commit arson, namely petrol, diesel, kerosene, turpentine, thinner and white spirit.
