

Issues about the clearing of road barricades by FSD personnel

The FSD noted the frequent occurrence of road blockage by barriers in public order events and violent incidents over the last few months. Such obstructions had not only caused inconvenience to the public, but also hampered the delivery of our emergency services. We have already reminded our frontline personnel that they may help remove the barriers when it is safe to do so, provided that resources permit and that emergency services and operation efficiency will not be undermined. Removal of such barriers will help clear roads for uninterrupted traffic flow, and enable fire appliances and ambulances to arrive at the scenes of emergency incidents promptly.
