Verbal conflict between personnel of the HKPF and the FSD (Central)

In the nighttime, a tear gas round hit a fire appliance during a dispersal operation by

the Police at Central and this led to a verbal conflict between a fire personnel on the

fire appliance and the police officers at the scene. Upon learning of the incident, it

was found that the fireman faced difficulties at the material time and understood that it

was a miscommunication.

In an attempt to tackle special situations that may occur in the future, the FSD has made

comprehensive arrangements on various fronts, such as operations and logistic support.

We will also enhance the guidelines on handling of violent incidents on the basis of

relevant operational experiences. The purpose of which is to provide most effective

emergency services to the public and ensure the safety of our personnel in different

circumstances.

We have all along required our personnel to perform their duties with dedication at all

times, act impartially, support the Government's administration in accordance with the

law and provide quality services to the public. We will also continue to maintain close

collaboration with the Police and strengthen mutual communication and coordination,

with a view to providing most effective emergency services to the public in different

circumstances.
