F.S.D. Circular Letter No. 1(Vent)/90 Changes of Services Provided By The Fire Services Department in respect of Ventilating Systems

As part of the phased programme to assist the Industry to realise self regulating, I hereby announce the following changes of services provided by the Fire Services Department in respect of ventilating systems with effect from the date of this letter :-

- (1) Ventilation Certificate (F.S. 224) will NOT be issued for the inspection of any ventilating system;
- (2) Ventilating systems installed in accordance with the Buildings (Ventilating Systems) Regulations will not normally be inspected, nor the plans processed by officers of this department, unless the design or the installation of the ventilating system is of such complex nature as to require-advice on fire protection measures within the meaning of Section 7(c) of the Fire Services Ordinance. Engineers and contractors are advised to:
 - (a) comply with Regulation 4 of the Buildings (Ventilating Systems) Regulations in respect of ventilating systems not requiring specific fire protection advice by making reference to technical circular letters published from time to time by this department; or

- (b) make request for processing of plans or inspection in respect of ventilating systems requiring specific fire protection advice. Upon acceptance and completion, a letter conveying such advice, free of charge, will be issued.
- Ventilating systems installed in accordance with the Ventilation of Scheduled Premises (UC/RC) By-laws will continue to be inspected as part of the requirements for the issue of Fire Certificate under By-laws 348/33B of the Food Business (UC/RC) By-laws. Upon satisfactory inspection of the system, a letter of compliance, free of charge, will be issued. If the design of the ventilating system is of such complex nature as to require specific fire protection advice, a request for the processing of plans may be made and upon acceptance and completion, a letter conveying such advice, free of charge, will be issued.
