Basic Law (BL) Written Test

The Basic Law (BL) written test is to assess candidates' knowledge of the BL. Candidates have to answer 15 multiple-choice questions in 25 minutes. The test result will constitute an appropriate weighting in a candidate's overall assessment. If you have attended a BL test arranged by other recruiting bureau/departments or the one centrally administered by the Civil Service Bureau, you can use the previous test result as your BL score and be exempted from sitting the test again. The previous BL test result will be accepted only upon your production of the original notification letter when attending the recruitment assessment. You may, if you so wish, take the BL test again, and the latest score obtained in the current recruitment exercise will be counted.
