Summary of Notes of Ventilation Installations Liaison Group Meeting held on 26.3.2004

Matters of Discussion

1.1 Departmental Business Study Report

- FSD and BD would review the existing policies on offences and penalties against RSC(V) with sub-standard work performed.
- To explore a proposed demerit point system and requirement for renewal registration of RSC(V) who repeatedly failed to perform to the relevant standards.
- ➤ Discussion between BD and FSD would be arranged on the possibility of transfer from BD to FS of registration and disciplining of ventilation contractors.
- All preliminary inspections to ventilating systems of licensed premises would be taken over by Regional Offices. On completion of the ventilation work, the applicant must complete Form 'Vent/425' and forward it direct to VD for arrangement of inspection.
- As fitted drawing was to be attached in Form D submission.
- it was proposed that FEHD had to be referred to and recommended for cancellation of the provisional licence if major defects were found.
- ➤ A list of common defects and approved / acceptable material would be put on FSD's website.

1.2 Certification of Ventilation Installation in New Buildings for Occupation Permit

- BD was requested to clarify the requirements of Gazette Notice 1406 issued on 27 March 1998 for specialized work to be carried out by RSC(V).
- The proposal of certification of ventilation installation in new building by RSC(V) prior to the issue of occupation permit would be considered by B.D.

1.3 Ventilation Work Under Cap 132

- ➤ Summary of discussion during FEHD / RSC(V) / VD meeting on 29.9.2003 :
 - Electrostatic Precipitator (EP) Installation
 EPD would be responsible for the quality of exhaust air and licensee should comply with other necessary requirement of FEHD & FSD.
 - Certification of Annual Inspection by RSC(V)
 FSD suggested FEHD to take action on outstanding defects being identified at MC submission prior to renewal of the licence.
 - FSD supported the proposal of employing RSC(V) to carry out ventilation installation under Cap 132.

1.4 Material Compliance and Approval

An up-dated FSD approved material list would be put on FSD website at end of May 2004.

1.5 Proposed De-merit Point System

Details regarding the set up and implementation was under discussion with the relevant trade representatives.

1.6 Annual inspection certification standard format

Proposed standard format had been forwarded to Department of Justice for comment.

1.7 Requirement of Licensee to Sign in Report for Work Completion

- FSD would review the requirement of licensee to sign on Report for Completion (Vent-425) in view of the practice of the trades.
- FEHD considered to take action on cancellation of the provisional licence for major defects being found. This requirement would ensure proper authorization by licensee for the inspection.
