2	Matters arising from last meeting
2.1.	Review of Protection Requirements against Fire and Smoke in Protected Areas
	<u>Mr. Sam CHAN</u> of HKRSVCA proposed a set of revised ventilating drawings for illustrative examples of typical provisions of fire dampers at compartment walls and, fire & smoke dampers at fire-rated ceilings in protected lobby/areas at eight (8) different scenarios to VILG for comment on 22.6.2021. Official comments from VD were issued to HKRSVCA on 23.6.2021. The meeting suggested simplifying illustration of the proposed floor part plan for protected areas which should be protected exit and protected lobby as defined in the Code of Practice for Fire Safety in Buildings (2011). <u>Mr. Sam CHAN</u> agreed to refine the presentation in the forms of schematic diagram for comments accordingly.
2.2.	Acceptance Inspection for Ventilating System in Licensed Premises
	HKRSVCA proposed a set of revised ventilating drawings for illustrative examples of ventilating system layouts with air ducts serving licensed premises and also communal air ducts with provision of fire dampers at compartment walls on 23.6.2021 to VILG for discussion in the meeting. VD agreed with general principles of proposal and advised general remarks for responsibilities of inspection of fire dampers by landlord and licensed premise were to be given. HKRSVCA agreed to refine the presentation with remarks for comments accordingly.
2.3	Mounting Method of Proprietary made Fire Damper
	The Secretary advised that there was no further update on the issue. This item would be deleted.

2.4 **Review of Part XI, FSD Circular Letter no. 4/96**

The Secretary informed the meeting that comments from members on the proposed updating to the subject of 'Mechanical Ventilating Systems' in the Circular Letter had been discussed in the 1st Sub-working Group Meeting held on 11.5.2021.
