Entry Requirements:

The candidates should -

- (i) be permanent residents of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region;
- (ii) be full-time students studying in accredited degree programmes with major in Chemistry, Mechanical Engineering, Statistics or related fields offered by local/non-local post-secondary institutions;
- (iii) have completed the first year of study and not be students graduating in 2023;
- (iv) be proficient in both written English and Chinese; and
- (v) have knowledge in general office computer skills.

Note: proficient in Microsoft Excel, Word and PowerPoint will be an advantage.

Duties:

- (i) To assist in organising seminars in relation to the implementation of the new dangerous goods regulatory regime;
- (ii) To update and maintain existing database of new energy development related projects in Hong Kong;
- (iii) To conduct research on international standards of new energy technology;
- (iv) To develop a relevant database regarding standards of new energy technology; and
- (v) To perform any other duties as assigned by senior officers.

Terms of Appointment:

Successful candidates will be appointed on non-civil service contract terms. Interns are normally required to work 44 hours per week, inclusive of meal breaks. Except otherwise provided, rest days, statutory holidays, paid leave, sickness days and sickness allowance, where appropriate, are generally in line with those provided for under the Employment Ordinance (Cap. 57). They are subject to

Mandatory Provident Fund Scheme Ordinance (Cap. 485).
